

Franklin Arts Academy Program & Pathway (for FHS Students in Grades 10, 11, and 12)

The FAA is a rigorous, 3-year interdisciplinary pathway offered at Franklin High School for grades 10, 11, and 12. Using multiple intelligence and interdisciplinary teaching models, students experience their academic courses (English, History, Science, & Math) with strong connections to architecture, design, music, theatre, visual arts, and video production.

The Franklin Arts Academy prepares a diverse community of aspiring scholars and artists to be successful in their college and professional careers and to be engaged members of our democratic society. The FAA operates as a focused learning community within the comprehensive school system of Franklin High School. The FAA offers both Honors and College Preparatory course levels. Entrance to the FAA for grades 10, 11, and 12 is through an application and review process. Applications are available in Guidance and on FHS website and are due January 30, 2015 for the 2015-16 school year.
